- 1. Approve minutes from June 25, 2024, meeting.
- 2. Kiosk discussion: Kate will talk to Jeff Solsa and P.D. Hardy about proper placement of a kiosk at the Park and Ride. We will gather ideas for kiosk designs and try to pick one for September's meeting. Our final design and proposal will need to be presented at a select board meeting.
- 3. Trails update: Mike hikes all our town trails every summer. Micki and Mike will hike Richardson's tomorrow. Mike has mowed many of the trails and does clearing on the ones that need it. J.T. will keep the Hemenway Ledges trail clear. Discussion of whether to change the name of Whitcomb Scenic Overlook to Whitcomb Town Forest. Further discussion of possible benefits when Steve F. is here.
- 4. SCC guided hikes and educational outreach series: Kate and Courtney had almost twenty children and adults attend their Crafting with Kids event at Old City Falls. Huge success and will be repeated next year. Some hikes were not as well attended so we may consolidate and be more careful in scheduling next year. Mike and JT hiked the cross town trail together.
